

Appointment of Liquor Agent:—
To Samuel S. Swasey of Lancaster in the County of Coös
and State of New Hampshire:—

Having confidence in your integrity and prudence, we hereby appoint you an Agent for the sale of Liquors as provided by Chapter 109 of the General Laws of New Hampshire, and to hold your office for one year, or until another is appointed, unless you shall be removed by the Selectmen:—

You shall conform to the following rules and regulations:—

- Ist You shall not make any purchase upon the Credit of the Town:—
- IInd You shall sell for cash only:—
- IIIrd You shall not sell to any person who is known to be habitual or occasionally intoxicated.
- IVth You shall not sell upon the Sabbath except in case of urgent necessity:—
- Vth You shall not sell to a minor except upon the written order of his parent, Master, Guardian or the written prescription of a Physician.
- VIth You shall keep an accurate account of your purchases and sales, with the particulars required by sections 10 and 11 of said Chapter.

Annual Meeting March 9th 1886.



The State of New Hampshire.

To the Inhabitants of the town of Lancaster qualified to vote in town affairs.

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall in said Town on the second Tuesday of March next at nine o'clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects

- 1st - To choose a Moderator to preside in said meeting.
- 2nd - To choose a Town Clerk for the ensuing year.
- 3rd - To choose three Selectmen and all other town officers for the year ensuing.
- 4th - To see what amount of money the town will vote to raise to meet the current expenses of the town and apply on the principal and interest of the Town Debt.
- 5th - To see if the town will vote to raise all the Highway Tax in money, and direct how the same be expended.
- 6th - To see what amount the town will vote to raise in labor for repairs of the Highways and Bridges, and direct how the same be expended.
- 7th - To see what amount the town will vote to raise in money for the repairs of Highways and Bridges.
- 8th - To see if the town will appoint a Liquor Agent.
- 9th - To see if the town will instruct the Selectmen to appoint an Agent to prosecute all persons who violate the law relative to selling Spiritous Liquors.
- 10th - To direct how the school money be divided.
- 11th - To see if the town will continue to vote to raise money for sidewalks and sewers in the Village, and for the support of the Fire Department, Hydrant, Street Lamps &c.

- 12th - To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the proper observance of Memorial Day -
- 13th - To see what action the town will take relative to aiding in the purchase of the Toll Bridge near Lancaster Village, for the purpose of making the same a free Bridge, and to raise money therefor - and provide for taking a proper conveyance thereof - and the approaches thereto -
- 14th - To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise towards paying the balance due for Force Pump, Water Wheel and Appurtenances (said balance being about \$600,) in Lancaster Village -
- 15th - To see if the town will vote to remove the Covered Bridge on Main Street across Trout River and replace the same with an Iron Bridge, and also what sum of money the town will raise for such purposes -
- 16th - To see what sum of money the town will vote to raise for the care, and the beautifying of our Cemetery, to be laid out and expended under the direction of the Selectmen -
- 17th - To see if the town will instruct the Selectmen to purchase of Horace F. Hutton the gravel bank situated on the northern side of the New Cemetery -

18th - Is it expedient that a convention be called to revise the Constitution -
